

September is Literacy Month in B.C.!

Campaign raises awareness and critical funds to support community literacy programs across the province

September 2023 – VANCOUVER – **Decoda Literacy Solutions and community literacy groups are partnering to celebrate the 10**th annual BC Literacy Month in September.

Mayors and city councils from across the province proclaim <u>Literacy Month</u> in September and BC landmarks light up in purple on September 8th to celebrate International Literacy Day. BC's provincial organization encourages everyone to #PutOnYourPurple in support of literacy programs in BC. The Literacy Month theme is "Literacy connects us!" Literacy connects us at home, at work and in the community.

"Decoda supports programs across the province that help increase the literacy and learning skills of children and families, adults and seniors. Literacy connects us at home, at work and in the community to improve quality of life," said Sandra Lee, executive director at Decoda Literacy Solutions. "There is a direct relationship between low literacy levels and poverty. Stronger literacy skills have a ripple effect to improve people's job opportunities, future education opportunities, health, civic participation, community connections — and improve their family's literacy."

B.C. Literacy Facts

- More than 700,000 people in BC struggle with literacy challenges.
- 45% of British Columbians aged 16 to 65 may have difficulty understanding newspapers, following instruction manuals, reading health information and other daily living tasks.
- 52% of British Columbians aged 16 to 65 may have difficulty calculating interest on a car loan, using information on a graph, calculating medicine dosage and other daily living tasks.
- 10.5% or 4,302 kindergarten children in all School Districts in BC were vulnerable on the Language & Cognitive Development scale of the Early Development Instrument in 2019-2022, and an additional 11% are at risk.
- A parent's literacy involvement in their children's activities matters for developing young children's literacy skills.
